


FROM ESTATE WORKER TO FARMER



Divyamalar's story is one of resilience and determination in the face of adversity. As a former estate worker and with her husband's injury, it was challenging for her to provide her children with a good education. However, when she heard about Australian Aid, Oxfam Australia facilitated the Poly-tunnel building program in her estate, she decided to take the opportunity and embark on a journey to become a farmer. The project has now been implemented by DevPro.

With the intervention of DevPro, Divyamalar's agricultural progress has taken a significant leap forward. With the generous provision of essential farming equipment, quality seeds and fertilizer, Divyamalar has been able to cultivate her land more efficiently and productively than ever before.

She primarily grows potatoes in her tunnel farm, which has been successful until 2021 when the pandemic hit and made it difficult for her to access the necessary fertilizer. Despite the challenges, she managed to earn around 7,000 to 10,000 rupees, which helped her send her children to school.




OVERCOMING SETBACKS
