
S P GUNAPALA MUCH MORE THAN A SPICE MAN

S. P. Gunapala is a successful cinnamon farmer who hails from Morawadiya and holds the esteemed position of Justice of Peace. He owes his success to the transformative training program provided by Oxfam, an international organization dedicated to improving the livelihoods of vulnerable communities.

OVERCOMING CHALLENGES OF TRADITIONAL FARMING

Before the intervention, Gunapala and other farmers in his locality followed traditional methods of manually crushing harvested cinnamon. This was unhygienic and unethical, and it limited their ability to produce high-quality cinnamon. However, Gunapala's potential was recognized and he was selected for training in January 2022. The program was comprehensive, covering topics such as product management, grinding, grading, and marketing of cinnamon. Over five days, Gunapala was taught about the thirteen different varieties of cinnamon and the value of cinnamon to the world market. This knowledge equipped them to produce various grades of cinnamon, including Alba, C5, C4, C3, and H2, which they now sell for much higher prices, from 2,000 to 6,000 rupees.




DETERMINED ASPIRATIONS






35KG INCREASE IN ANNUAL PRODUCTION
